When asking questions in ASL, there are 2 main forms of question.

1. For **WH questions** (who, what, where, why, when and how) your eyebrows will go down at the end.

2. For Yes/No questions, your eyebrow will go up at the end.

**QUESTION WORDS:** 

How are you? HOW YOU (WH-?) ME [Choose appropriate sign] ME I am (excited, confused, etc). What is your name? YOU NAME WHAT YOU (WH-?) My name is \_\_\_\_ MY NAME (fs) [YOUR NAME] Where do you live? YOU LIVE WHERE YOU (WH-?) I live in Texas. I LIVE (fs) [CITY/STATE] Are you hearing? YOU HEARING YOU (Y/N-?) Yes, I am hearing. What about you? YES, ME HEARING ME (Pause) YOU (WH-?) Where is the bathroom? BATHROOM WHERE (WH-?) The bathroom is over there. BATHROOM THERE (point to bathroom) Are you learning ASL? YOU ASL LEARN YOU (WH-?) YES. ME ASL LEARN ME Yes. I am learning ASL.
